CURRICULUM

ELA: We are reading Bud, Not Buddy and studying the genre of mystery. Students are learning about the elements of mysteries by reading two-minute mysteries, then they will use this information to write their own mystery.

Science: Students are learning more about chemical reactions. Students will conduct reactions and use atom models and chemical formulas to represent those reactions as equations.

Social Studies: Students will be learning about the history of ice harvesting. They will be studying the who, what, when, where, how and why of ice harvesting, as well as harvesting ice on ponds and prairies.
