Curriculum Notes

ELA: We will continue to read A Christmas Carol. Students will identify cause and effect as Scrooge continues his visits with the three ghosts. Students will study vocabulary, and respond to various prompts for writing about their connections to events in the story.

Social Studies: Students will begin their world religions study. They will learn about Buddhism, Judaism, Hinduism, Christianity, and Islam in relation to the Eastern Hemisphere.
