Charged Laptop

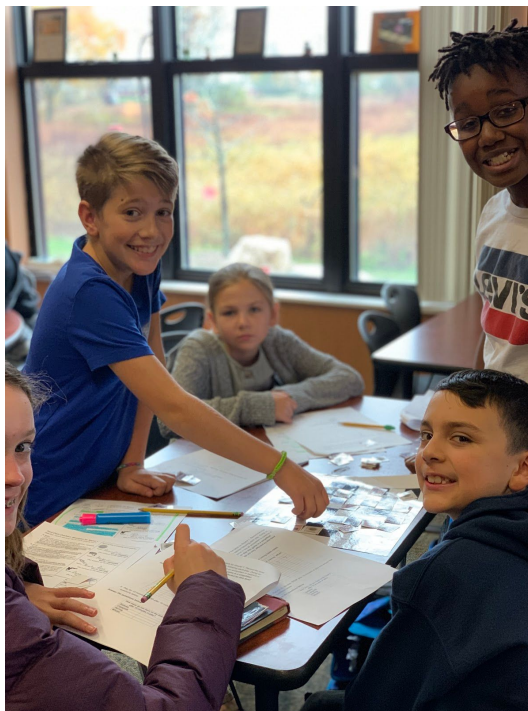
Students are expected to come to school each day with a charged laptop. Please remind students to charge their laptop.

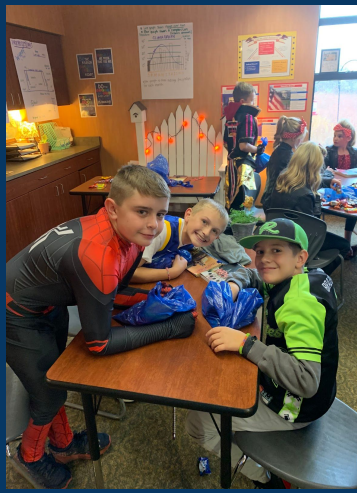
To better understand how an ecosystem functions, students played Food Chain Checkers.
