Curriculum Notes

ELA: Students will continue reading Out of the Dust by Karen Hesse. This will be done as a classroom read-aloud. Students will continue working on the digital assignment connecting to comprehension and vocabulary with the story. We will learn about reading and writing poetry. Students will write several poems, and prepare to read at least one aloud at our Poetry Cafe on the last day of school.

Social Studies: Students will be working on their Pure Michigan Presentations. This will include Sault Ste. Marie, Mackinac Island and Fort Michilimackinac's features and history.
