# Student Behavior Expectations

## And Guidelines 2024

### Pure Michigan 7th Grade Trip

**Check in time 6:30 a.m. May 28th.**

#### **Medicine:**

Prescription Medication must be in the original container with just enough for the trip. Put medication in a small Ziploc bag with the student's name on it in permanent marker and give it to teachers. Mrs. Fennelly and Mrs. Logan will keep and distribute the medication per parent directions. *Completing the form from the Chatfield School office is required with parent signature for prescription medication.* Students may not share any medication with others.

#### **Buddies:**

You must always travel with your buddy. **You may not go anywhere without your chaperone.** You may not leave your hotel room after lights out.

#### **Discipline:**

All students are expected to be respectful to all adults and their peers. They are also expected to follow directions and participate in group activities. Finally, Chatfield staff and chaperones will expect students to understand the rules and expectations noted in this document. If a problem occurs and is not corrected we will not hesitate to call home or send the student home.

When an adult talks....**LISTEN**

Know times to meet and places to meet.

Be there and be ON TIME.

Stay with your chaperone at all times.

## Bus Rules:

- Students must stay in a seat for the duration of the trip (NO laying on the floor).
- DO NOT USE THE BATHROOM ON THE BUS- We make enough stops.
- At stops everybody gets off with their buddy.
- Clean up after yourself/ keep your area clean..
- Label all items in case items are lost/left behind.
- No perfume or sprays of any kind on the bus.
- Keep overhead compartments closed.
- Adults are not responsible for your items.
- Pop, juice and water should have a twist top only. **No Energy Drinks.**
- Movies shown on bus televisions will be G or PG rated and approved by staff.

## Rules and Expectations:

- Always stay with your buddy.
- STUDENTS ARE ONLY PERMITTED TO ENTER THEIR ASSIGNED HOTEL ROOM.
- Keep your room neat and organized. Be respectful of everyone's space and quiet time (Go to sleep at night!).
- You must shower regularly as needed.
- All students will be expected to maintain clean areas and take care of trash and belongings (items on the floor may cause accidents).
- ALWAYS listen to tour guides/teachers/chaperones with your FULL attention.
- When embarking or disembarking the bus, be swift and respectful (traffic laws).
- Pay attention to meeting locations and times.

## **Cell Phone Policy:**

Students will **NOT** be allowed to take cell phones on this trip. If the need arises, students will be able to use a staff cell phone to call home. Chatfield staff and students chaperone cell phone numbers will be provided for emergency use only. Please do not call emergency numbers for non-emergencies. Chatfield staff and chaperones will check their phones as often as possible. Any cell phone that is brought on the trip will be taken and held until we return to school. Staff will NOT be responsible for any student cell phone they have had to confiscate and students may lose privileges for breaking this rule.
